### ART 2000 SPECIAL TOPICS IN STUDIO ART

#### **Blacksmithing and Foundry I—ART 2000 P01**

An introductory course in blacksmithing and foundry taught by one of the South's premier blacksmiths, Mike Rose. The course will cover forge and foundry operations, emphasizing the process as it pertains to sculptural expression. It will also include green sand aluminum casting and pattern making. Students will learn to forge steel and create projects of their own design.

#### **Watercolor I—ART 2000 P70**

An introductory course in watercolor, taught by award-winning regional watercolorist Marty Komorny. The course will begin with the basics and lead students step by step through selection and use of watercolor materials, watercolor techniques, and development of personal images.

### EXCITING NEW COURSES IN VIDEO PRODUCTION TECHNOLOGY!

#### **MDT 1600 Game Design and Development**

Designed to be the first of several classes for students interested in learning how video games are created. Through lecture and projects, students will learn and apply game theory and strategy and discover some of the tools used to design and program games. Upon completion of this course, students will be prepared to continue on a design and/or programming track.

#### **VPT 1020 Special Topics: Multicam Field Production**

A hybrid course designed as a field production practicum, this course affords students the opportunity to use some of the latest video production technology to participate in location recording of school-related events. Students will produce, direct and operate cameras and audio systems as part of this hands-on course. Suggested prereqs are VPT 1045 and VPT 1090.
