Students planning to transfer to UTK must have completed their last 30 semester hours of credit at UT Knoxville and at least 60 semester hours of credit at a four-year college or university. During the final 30 hours, up to two courses outside a student's major may be taken at another institution as long as the student has 25% of coursework for the degree completed at UT Knoxville (https://catalog.utk.edu/content.php?catoid=24&navoid=3079#Transfer_Admission).

NOTE: While not a requirement for the AS degree at Pellissippi State, students may complete ECE 2010, ECE 2020, MATH 2010, MATH 2110, MATH 2120 and PHYS 2120 at Pellissippi State for transfer to UTK.
