

READ 0900/COLL 1500 Advising Chart

Rather than just being a list all of the courses that a student can take if they are currently enrolled in READ 0900/COLL 1500, this chart is constructed with the advising process in mind. This first chart contains the courses that satisfy PSCC General Education requirements that students can take while enrolled in co-requisite Reading.

¹Students who have a Reading requirement cannot take a standalone ENGL 1010. Furthermore, students who are college-level in English cannot take co-requisite ENGL 1010. Therefore, a student who is college-level in English but not Reading will not be able to take ENGL 1010.
