Students lacking two years of study in the same foreign language must complete one year of beginning foreign language prior to enrolling in intermediate courses.

²HUM Chosen from ARTH 2010, 2020; ENGL 2110, 2120, 2210, 2220, 2310, 2320, 2331, 2510, 2520, 2530, 2810; MUS 1030; PHIL 1030, 1300, 1500, 2010, 2400; PHO 1200; THEA 1030.

³WPE Chosen from ECON 2200, GEOG 2010 (ROCC), HIST 1120, PHIL 2010, POLS 1020. Students planning to transfer must check the requirements of the intended college or university. ECON 2020 is required for transfer to UTK. GEOG 2010 is offered online through the TN eCampus, a cooperative online enterprise among 6 universities, 13 community colleges, including Pellissippi State, and 27 colleges of applied technology in Tennessee.

⁴HIST Chosen from an unduplicated course: HIST 1010, 1020, 1110, 1120, 2010, 2020. Students planning to transfer to out-of-state or private universities must check requirements and complete the appropriate courses.

⁵ENGL Chosen from ENGL 2110, 2120, 2210, 2220, 2310, 2320, 2331, 2510, 2520, 2530.

⁶GE Chosen from any unduplicated transferable course. Students planning to transfer must check course equivalency tables and/or catalogs of the intended college or university.

⁷NS Chosen from BIOL 1110, 1120, 2010, 2020; BOT 1010, 1020; CHEM 1010, 1020, 1110, 1120; GEOL 1040, 1050, 1300; PHYS 2010, 2020, 2110, 2120.

⁸SBS Chosen from ANT 1300; ECON 2200; GEOG 1000; HIST 2040; PHED 1100; POLS 1020, 1030; PSYC 1030, 2100, 2120, 2130; SOCI 1010, 1020; WMN 2200.

Tennessee Transfer Pathways constitute agreements between community colleges and four-year colleges and universities confirming that community college courses meet major preparation requirements and guaranteeing that all community college courses taken will be accepted at the Tennessee college/ university and will count toward completion of the specific major.
