<sup>6</sup>GE Chosen from any unduplicated transferable course. Students planning to transfer must check course equivalency tables and/or catalogs of the intended college or university. BIOL 2010 is required for transfer to UTM.

<sup>7</sup>HIST Chosen from HIST 1010, HIST 1020, HIST 1110, HIST 1120, HIST 2010, HIST 2020. Students planning to transfer to out-of-state or private universities must check requirements and complete the appropriate courses.

<sup>8</sup>ENGL Chosen from ENGL 2110, ENGL 2120, ENGL 2210, ENGL 2220, ENGL 2310, ENGL 2320, ENGL 2331, ENGL 2510, ENGL 2520, ENGL 2530.

### **Additional Information Regarding Foreign Language**

At some universities, foreign language may be required in certain programs that lead to the bachelor of science degree. Complete information regarding foreign language requirements at each university is on the transfer and articulation websites of the Tennessee Board of Regents and the University of Tennessee System. Community college students are encouraged to be familiar with foreign language requirements at the universities and, if applicable, complete the requirements before transferring.

### **Tennessee Transfer Pathways**

Tennessee Transfer Pathways constitute agreements between community colleges and four-year colleges and universities confirming that community college courses meet major preparation requirements and guaranteeing that all community college courses taken will be accepted at the Tennessee college/university and will count toward completion of the specific major. The following Tennessee public universities offer programs to complete these Pathways: East Tennessee State University, Middle Tennessee State University, Tennessee State University, University of Memphis, University of Tennessee at Chattanooga, University of Tennessee at Knoxville, and University of Tennessee at Martin.
