

COURSES REQUIRED FOR LINCOLN MEMORIAL UNIVERSITY NURSING PROGRAM (ASN)

Students completing these courses will meet the minimum course requirements for admission into the Lincoln Memorial University Associate of Science in Nursing Program.

* Starred courses are strongly recommended prior to beginning Nursing courses at LMU.

Completion of these courses does not guarantee admission into LMU's Nursing Program. An application for admission into the LMU Nursing Program must be submitted and the student must be accepted. Acceptance is substantially improved by a high GPA. Students who have completed the required science courses with excellent grades are given priority.

Students must apply to both the college and to the nursing school. Students should check with the college and the nursing school to determine application deadlines, which may be well in advance of the entrance dates.

Note that course requirements may change. It is the student's responsibility to check with the LMU Nursing Program to make sure all courses will transfer and are acceptable. This is especially true if the courses were taken at other colleges or universities. See the LMU Catalog for more information on admission requirements for the college and for the Nursing Program.

Completion of these courses does not result in a degree from PSTCC. Additional courses are required; see your PSTCC advisor for more information.
