¹FREN/GERM/SPAN A sequence is required for Associate of Arts degrees only. Students lacking two years of study in the same foreign language should take one year of beginning foreign language prior to enrolling in intermediate courses (replaces general electives). Associate of Science students should substitute electives for the 6 hours of foreign language.

²HIST Select sequence from HIST 1010-1020, 1110-1120, 2010-2020. Students who plan to transfer to out-of-state or private universities should check requirements and take the appropriate courses.

³MATH Enrollment in MATH 1630 requires completion of MATH 1130 or an ACT math score of at least 21 and completion of precalculus.
