² Students who plan to transfer to Austin Peay State University, East Tennessee State University, and the University of Tennessee, Chattanooga must complete Computer Science I & II (Programming) instead of Computer Applications and General Electives. For these students, the total hours in the Area of Emphasis will be 20 hours and total degree hours will be 61.

³MATH Enrollment in MATH 1630 requires completion of MATH 1130 or an ACT math score of at least 21 and completion of precalculus. Enrollment in MATH 1830 requires completion of MATH 1130 or an ACT math score of at least 23 and completion of precalculus. (Note: MATH 1630 does not prepare a student for MATH 1830.)

⁵HIST Select sequence from HIST 1010-1020, 1110-1120, 2010-2020. Students who plan to transfer to out-of-state or private universities should check requirements and take the appropriate courses.

⁷MATH Students who plan to transfer to the University of Tennessee must complete MATH 2050, Introduction to Statistics.

⁸GE General Electives: Any transferable course; check course equivalency tables and/or catalogs of the college or university to which the student intends to transfer.
