

**PELLISSIPPI STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
REQUIREMENTS  
Nursing (AASN)**

Students completing the listed courses will meet the general education requirements for the Pellissippi State Community College Associate of Applied Science in Nursing Program. Completion of these courses does NOT result in a degree from PSCC. Additional courses are required; see your PSCC advisor for more information. Completion of these courses does not guarantee admission into PSCC's Nursing Program. Students must apply and be accepted BOTH to the College and to the PSCC's nursing program. Students should check with the College and the Nursing Department to determine application deadlines.

- \* **Highly recommend completion by the application deadline (January 31) with a C or higher. May NOT be repeated more than once.**
- + **Highly recommend completion by the application deadline (January 31) with a C or higher. May NOT be repeated more than once. Highly recommend completion before the student begins nursing classes in August.**
- # **Recommend completion before the student begins nursing classes in August. If not, this course MUST be taken with first semester nursing class. Must be completed with a C or higher.**

Admission is highly competitive and is based on the following: (1) a student's overall GPA in general education courses required for the A.A.S.N. degree (a 2.5 GPA is the minimum for consideration) and (2) scores on the Nursing Entrance Exam. Extra weight will be given for required science courses completed with a grade of B or higher by January 31, completed higher education degrees (MS, MA, BS, BA, AS, AAS, AA), and current health science licensures and certifications (CNA, LPN, EMT, EMT-P, DC). Students must also demonstrate computer competency in areas of word processing, Excel, PowerPoint, and internet searches. Science courses may not be more than 5 years old upon entering the first semester of the nursing program. Completion of these courses does not guarantee admission into PSCC's Nursing Program. An application for admission into the PSCC Nursing Program must be submitted, and the student must be accepted. Students must apply BOTH to the College (non-PSCC students) and to the nursing program (ALL STUDENTS). The deadline for the nursing program application is January 31. Students should apply to the College earlier.

**Note that course and admission requirements may change. It is the student's responsibility to check with the PSCC Nursing Department to verify that all coursework will transfer. See the PSCC Catalog for more information on admission requirements for the College and for the Nursing Department.**
