

COURSES REQUIRED FOR WALTERS STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE NURSING PROGRAM (AAS in Nursing)

Students completing these courses will meet the minimum course requirements for admission into the Walters State Community College Associate of Applied Science in Nursing Program.

***Must be completed with a C or higher prior to the application ranking process. Note that students with more credits completed are given high priority toward admission. Students should complete as many science courses as possible before applying, as high science grades improve chance of acceptance. Also, students may receive additional ranking points toward admission by taking the Nurse Entrance Test, given by WSCC.**

Completion of these courses does not guarantee admission into WSCC’s Nursing Program. An application for admission into the WSCC Nursing Program must be submitted and the student must be accepted. Acceptance is substantially improved by a high GPA.

Students must apply to both the college and to the nursing school. Students should check with the college and the nursing school to determine application deadlines, which may be well in advance of the entrance dates.

Note that course requirements may change. It is the student’s responsibility to check with the WSCC Nursing Program to make sure all courses will transfer and are acceptable. This is especially true if the courses were taken at other colleges or universities. See the WSCC Catalog for more information on admission requirements for the college and for the Nursing Program.

Completion of these courses does not result in a degree from PSTCC. Additional courses are required; see your PSTCC advisor for more information.
