This program leads to an Associate of Science in Teaching from Pellissippi State Community College and a Bachelor of Science in Liberal Studies and Human Development from Lincoln Memorial University. Lincoln Memorial University requires a minimum of 128 semester hours for the baccalaureate degree; a minimum of 60 semester hours must be completed at a senior level institution. **The Associate of Science in Teaching requires a 2.75 GPA for completion.** The following is a **suggested** four-year program of study.

Note: Students entering the teacher licensure program must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Candidates must submit an enhanced ACT composite score of 22, an SAT combined score of 1020 or a PRAXIS I (PPST) with Reading score of 174, Writing of 173 and Math of 173 prior to admission to the teacher education program. Students should submit test scores to the education department the semester prior to enrolling at LMU. If needed, students can retake the admission test during their first semester of enrollment at LMU.
