SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE - TRANSFER STUDENTS

HELLO.

To be considered for TTU scholarships, you need only to fill out the New Student Scholarship Application. One application makes you eligible for all TTU scholarships for which you meet the criteria. Please refer to our website at tntech.edu/scholarships for detailed scholarship application procedures. We encourage students to submit their applications online. We encourage you to submit your application beginning **Aug. 15, 2010**. The annual deadline for scholarship applications for 2011-2012 is **Dec. 15, 2010**.

CHECKLISTS.

Follow these checklists for the admission application process and the scholarship application process for transfer students.

Admission Application Process

- Apply for admission to TTU online (tntech.edu/applyonline) or by paper application.
- Submit \$25 application fee
- Have all transcripts submitted to the Office of Admissions by Jan. 15, 2011. (If the student hasn't already earned a bachelor's degree, the student must also submit an official high school transcript.)

Scholarship Application Process

- Complete checklist for admission application process.
- Apply for scholarships online at tntech.edu/scholarships through ScholarWeb by Dec. 15, 2010.
- Complete and submit the Financial Aid Estimate Form (if you wish to be considered for need-based scholarships).
- Check to see if your major requires additional documents such as recommendation letters, essays, etc. under the Checklists by Major menu on the Scholarships website. The deadline to submit supporting documents is Jan. 15, 2011.

IMPORTANT DATES.

Remember, you must apply for admission and scholarships by **Dec. 15, 2010**, to be eligible for any TTU scholarship award for 2011-2012. Please review the Scholarships website (tntech.edu/scholarships) for more detailed application information, deadline information, and answers to frequently asked questions. Although online application is encouraged, hard copies of the application can be accessed at the Scholarships website under the Forms menu.

- Dec. 15** | Scholarship application deadline
- Jan. 15** | Supporting materials must be submitted to the Scholarship Office
- March 15** | Initial notification to students selected as scholarship recipients

GUIDELINES.

2011-2012 Academic Scholarships

All students who apply for admission and scholarships by **December 15, 2010**, will be considered for the following Admissions Scholarships. These scholarships are guaranteed only to the extent that necessary funding is available.

COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP*

\$2,500 Year, 3.5 community college GPA at the end of second semester of sophomore year. This scholarship is awarded to those students who are recipients of the Tennessee Board of Regents Academic Service or Presidential Scholarship at their Tennessee community college. It will be renewable as long as the student maintains 12 credit hours each semester with a 3.0 cumulative GPA and completes 75 hours of university service.

ALL TENNESSEE ACADEMIC TEAM SCHOLARSHIP*

The two Phi Theta Kappa winners chosen by their Tennessee Board of Regents community college to be their designated selection for the All Tennessee Academic Team will receive a \$4,000 scholarship from Tennessee Tech University. This scholarship will be renewable as long as the student maintains 12 credit hours with a 3.0 cumulative GPA each semester and provides 75 hours of service.

PHI THETA KAPPA SCHOLARSHIP*

Tennessee Tech offers two \$3,000 scholarships to the two community college transfer students who have the highest academic credentials and maintain full membership in Phi Theta Kappa. A letter of recommendation from their Phi Theta Kappa advisor is recommended for scholarship consideration. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and an A.A., A.S., or A.A.S. degree or 60 credit hours. Students will also be required to provide 75 hours of university service each semester. This scholarship will be renewable as long as students maintain 12 credit hours with a 3.0 cumulative GPA each semester.

TTU TRANSFER HONORS SCHOLARSHIP*

Tennessee Tech offers a \$2,500 scholarship to two students from each of the following community colleges: Chattanooga State Community College, Cleveland State Community College, Columbia State Community College, Jackson State Community College, Motlow State Community College, Nashville State Community College, Northeast State Community College, Pellissippi State Community College, Roane State Community College, Volunteer State Community College, and Walters State Community College. The president of their respective community college must nominate these students. The scholarship is renewable as long as the student maintains 12 credit hours with a 3.0 cumulative GPA each semester. This scholarship requires 75 hours of service each semester.

ADMISSIONS LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP*

A \$1,000 one-year-only scholarship will be awarded to a limited number of transfer students who have demonstrated outstanding leadership potential.

TTU DEPARTMENTAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Departments award scholarships to students who have demonstrated leadership in the classroom and in their major. These awards are for various amounts and are based on different criteria.

Tennessee Technological University reserves the right to limit scholarship awards if necessary funding is not available.
*Students may only receive one of these awards from the Scholarship Office.
