ACTIONS TAKEN

- I.** Ely Driver, the 2003-04 CDC chair, welcomed members to the meeting and allowed each to introduce themselves. New members include: Mike Hudson, Business and Community Services; Carolyn Renier, Mathematics department; and Jane Schumann, Natural and Behavioral Sciences department.
- II.** An update was given regarding the TBR general education proposal. TBR rejected five PSTCC courses that were submitted for general education: MATH 1735 (Precalculus W/ Calculus Part I); PHYS 1310 & 1320 (Mechanics & Heat W/ Lab I & II); PSY 2200 (Behavior & Experience); and SPH 2400 (Business & Professional Speaking). Appeals have already been sent to TBR for all the courses. TBR did not provide us with a timeline for appeal decisions. Overall, PSTCC faired well compared to other schools. It has still not been determined if TBR will create one, state-wide list for general education or allow individual schools to maintain their own lists.
- III.** Ely Driver reviewed the contents of the CDC notebook and CDC's goals/functions to acquaint new members with the process. The regular meeting time will continue to be Thursdays at 3:00 in AL 220.
- IV.** A chart listing the 2003 summer curriculum changes was distributed (see attached).
