Admission into the College of Nursing is based on the number of available clinical positions. The minimum acceptable grade for all courses in this specified curriculum is a "C". If the number of petitions for clinical positions exceeds the number of students that can be accommodated, students will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:

- Cumulative GPA for courses completed
- Cumulative GPA for required science, social science, math, and English courses
- Number of course withdrawals and repetitions
- Grade improvement over time
- Probability of completing all required courses in the freshman and sophomore curriculum prior to fall semester
- Interest in and commitment to nursing.
- Availability of space

In recent years, the number of applications has increased dramatically; therefore, students are encouraged to apply to more than one program. Pellissippi State students must submit a Petition for Progression form to UT's College of Nursing Student Services Office by January 20 of the sophomore year.
