This program leads to an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree from Pellissippi State and a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science from the University of Tennessee depending on the chosen major field.

PELLISSIPPI STATE

Students should choose one of the programs which will prepare them to transfer into their major program at UT. The student should complete *Psychology 2100: The Psychology of Human Development* at Pellissippi State with a minimum grade of C.

UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE

The student will continue his/her major at the University of Tennessee with a minor in secondary education.

Teacher licensure is granted at the successful completion of the Professional Year; 12 additional hours may be taken to complete the Masters Degree.
