

## Postsecondary Tech Prep Student Criteria

A postsecondary Tech Prep student is an individual that receives credit from the postsecondary institution based upon demonstrated attainment of equivalent learning outcomes for specified courses. The gaining of benefit to the student may occur through secondary-postsecondary career-technical course articulation, career/technical dual enrollment, BAT apprenticeship programs, a TTC-college collaboration, or military articulation. The student should be identified as a Tech Prep student though the credit may be escrowed for conditional transcription at the time of enrollment.

<b>Career and Technical Articulation:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The individual has completed a secondary course of study and has received a regular high school diploma;</li> <li>2. He/she has enrolled in the institution of higher education (i.e., university or two-year college) within two years of secondary graduation; and</li> <li>3. The individual demonstrates attainment of equivalent learning outcomes for specified courses and will receive credit through the career and technical Tech Prep articulation process.</li> </ol>
<b>Dual Enrollment</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The individual is a secondary technical- or dual-path student who completes a postsecondary level career/technical course provided by a postsecondary institution.</li> <li>2. The individual receives college credit for the completed course that shall appear on the student's college transcript.</li> <li>3. The credit is issued under a Tech Prep articulation agreement.</li> </ol>
<b>Academic-Vocational Articulation</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The individual has completed a secondary course of study and has received a regular high school diploma;</li> <li>2. He/she has enrolled in the institution of higher education (i.e. community college) within two years of secondary graduation; and</li> <li>3. Demonstrates attainment of equivalent learning outcomes for specified postsecondary career/technical courses (A.A.S. related) though the secondary articulated course is not funded as a career/technical course (e.g. accounting) by the State Department of Education.</li> <li>4. Meets all other requirements for career and technical Tech Prep articulated credit.</li> </ol>
<b>Apprenticeship</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The incoming student has completed a Department of Labor (BAT) approved apprenticeship program of study (student may be more than two years out of secondary education);</li> <li>2. Demonstrates attainment of equivalent learning outcomes for specified postsecondary career/technical courses; and</li> <li>3. Meets all other requirements for career/ technical Tech Prep articulated credit.</li> </ol>
<b>TTC to College</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Completes a Diploma-level course of study at a Tennessee Technology Center (student may be more than two-years out of secondary education);</li> <li>2. Demonstrates attainment of equivalent learning outcomes for specified postsecondary career/technical courses or for the general technology major or equivalent in accordance with TBR policy 2:01:00:03.</li> <li>3. Meets all other requirements for career and technical Tech Prep articulated credit.</li> </ol>
