- 1** SPAN Required for Associate of Arts degrees only. Students lacking two years of study in the same foreign language should take one year of the introductory Spanish prior to enrolling in the intermediate courses. Associate of Science students should substitute the six hours of foreign language with electives.
- 2** HIST History sequence is HIST 1010, 1020 or 2010, 2020. Students who plan to transfer to Tennessee Board of Regents universities should take 6 hours of U.S. history. Students who plan to transfer to University of Tennessee universities, out-of-state, or private universities should check with the receiving institution to take the appropriate sequence.
