

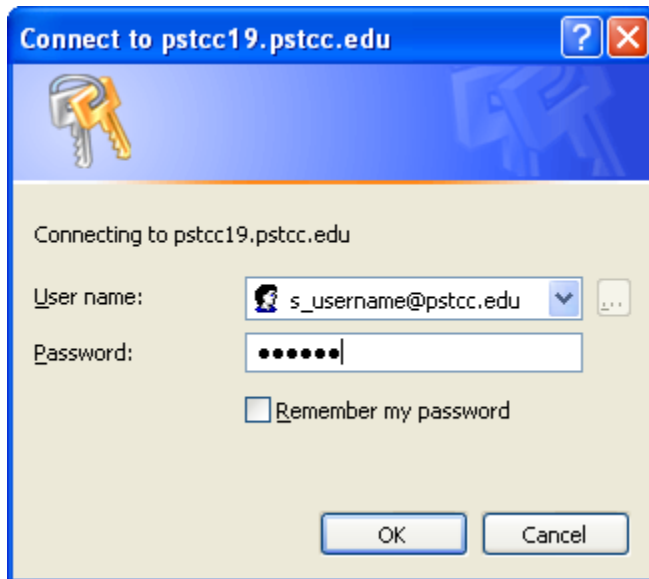
McAfee Virus Protection

Please follow these guidelines in order to download the latest version of McAfee to your personal computer running one the following operating systems: Windows NT 4.0, 2000, or XP.

Click on the following link to begin the download – you will be prompted for your username and password. This is the same student, faculty or staff username as used for on-campus computer login, E-mail and WebCT as shown in the example (include domain @pstcc.edu). Please note that pop-up blockers must be disabled in order to permit the username / password window to appear.

Here are sample screens from Internet Explorer using Windows XP but these screens will not be the same as other operating systems / browsers, and are provided solely as an example.



If username and password are correct, you will be asked to run or save the file. This is a large file and depending on the type of ISP (internet service provider) you use, the download could take several minutes. We suggest you save the file to the desktop. Once the download is complete simply double click on the file for installation. Depending on how your system is set up your files may download as zipped files and need to be extracted. NOTE: You may also download and burn to CD/flash drive on campus for installation at home.



Once you have downloaded and installed the file – you should update your dat files regularly to keep current with any new viruses that might be released.

To update your dat files simply right click on the McAfee virus shield in the system tray and choose 'update now'. You can also choose to have the dat files updated automatically.
