#### GEN ED 1

General education elective to be chosen from one unduplicated course in the categories of Communication, Humanities/Fine Arts, Mathematics or Natural Sciences, or Social/Behavioral Sciences in the General Education section of this Catalog. Students should check with advisor for relevant electives.

#### MDT 2

Media Technologies electives to be chosen from CGT 1105, 1950; PHO 1200, 2100, 2500; VPT 1045, VPT 1220, WEB 1600 based on students' career needs and interests. Electives must be approved by the student's advisor or the program coordinator. Some courses may require prerequisites.

#### PHO 3

Photography electives to be chosen from COM 1500, JOU 2000, 2030; MKT 2200; PHO 1200, 2100, 2500, 2700, 2950 based on students' career needs and interests. Electives must be approved by

the student's advisor or the program coordinator. Some courses may require prerequisites.

#### CORE 4

Core Photography Requirements to be chosen from PHO 2200, 2300 or 2400, with the order based on students' career needs and interests. All courses require prerequisites. All Core Requirements must be passed in order to graduate.

† It is recommended that Capstone courses be taken in the final semester for students completing the sequence in four semesters. Those students completing the sequence in more than four semesters should consider enrolling in capstone courses in the Fall Semester prior to graduation.
