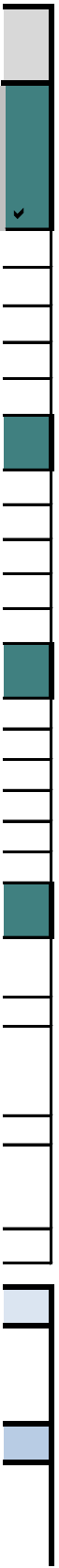
General Education Electives
