

DIGITAL IMAGING FOR PHOTOGRAPHY

The Digital Imaging for Photography curriculum is designed for the amateur or media professional interested in adding digital imaging/editing and photo manipulation skills. It is also a career option for someone interested in working as a digital imaging technician in the photographic support industry. The certificate is useful for someone who uses imaging software like Adobe Photoshop® as part of his or her profession, or those amateurs wishing to broaden their artistic capabilities. All of the courses are hands-on and practical and are taught by experienced professionals. **Courses in each level (Foundation, Core, Advanced Track) must be completed prior to advancing to the next level. Where more than one course is offered within a level, courses may be taken in any sequence.**
