Your Photo Student ID is also your library card. ALL students, faculty, and staff are required to get a Photo ID.

The first ID is free.

At the Division Street campus, go to the ERC, Room 208. Bring a photo ID and know your P- number. Replacement ID's cost \$10.

Reference Workstations. We are always happy to assist you in your research needs. Four reference workstations are loaded with access to the internet as well as a variety of databases (many full-text), such as:

--Academic OneFile, Discovering Collection, Westlaw, Literature Resource Center, Access Science, Business Decisions Academic, Lexis Nexis, Wilson Omnifile, and the Pellissippi Online Catalog, are available for research.

Interlibrary Loan Service. If the book you need is not available at Division Street, you may request it from the Pellissippi campus

library. Within 1-2 days, your book can be picked up at the Div. St. ERC circulation desk, Room 208.

UT/TBR Borrower's Card. Students, faculty, and staff are eligible for a Tennessee Board of Regents/Univ. of Tennessee borrower's card that authorizes borrowing privileges at the UT Library and any TBR school. These cards are valid for one semester.

The card allows you to check out books only—no periodicals or computer lab privileges. You will be responsible for any fines at the lending library.
