Welcome to Theatre in Video!

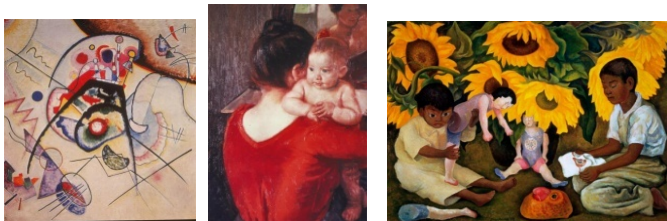
Theatre in Video contains more than 250 definitive performances of the world's leading plays, together with more than 100 film documentaries, online in streaming video - more than 500 hours in all. This release contains 279 titles, representing hundreds of leading playwrights, actors and directors. Included are landmark performances such as *The Iceman Cometh*, *Awake and Sing!*, *Don Juan*, *Bérénice*, *Long Day's Journey Into Night*, *Playboy of the Western World*, *Krapp's Last Tape*, and the complete works of Shakespeare as produced by the BBC and other theatrical companies. Notable actors include Claire Bloom, Laurence Olivier, Colleen Dewhurst, Richard Dreyfuss, Walter Matthau, Meryl Streep, Anthony Hopkins, Helen Mirren and more. For the first time, students, instructors and researchers can bookmark specific scenes, monologues and staging, and these landmark performances can become a permanent part of the curriculum.

Seminal productions here include works such as *Master Builder*, *Tartuffe*, *The Iceman Cometh*, *Medea*, *Playboy of the Western World*, *King Lear*, *Long Day's Journey into Night*, *The Orestia*, and *Six Characters in Search of an Author*, among many others.

Visit **ARTstor**, a repository of hundreds of thousands of digital images and related data. **ARTstor** is a non-profit initiative, founded by The Andrew W. Mellon Foundation, with a mission to use digital technology to enhance scholarship, teaching, and learning in the arts and associated fields.

You will find a collection of digital images from many U.S. and foreign museums, as well as:

- a collection of 190,000 old master drawings originally photographed at over 100 different repositories, 20 years of contemporary New York City gallery shows, archives of Islamic textiles,
- the restored Ghiberti "Gates of Paradise,"
- African masks, medieval manuscripts, images of all exhibitions shown at Museum of Modern Art (MoMA), and many others.
